Trina will need to make a decision if we are going to condense the tournament into one location. Trina will make the decision within the next two weeks and will share with Shannon regarding concessions.

**New Business:**

3. Track - Discussion was held on the possibility of putting in a long jump pit and a cement pad for the discus and shot put behind the baseball/softball diamonds.
