

BOOSTER CLUB MEETING MINUTES - Wednesday, October 6, 2010

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Finance

Golf outing profit @ \$8,900. Some sponsorships may still be outstanding. Pat will work with Dawn and the committee to confirm all sponsorships are paid (some paid one check for multiple items at the tournament).

We received a check for two cars donated to the scrap metal drive from Lee & Deb Rottinghaus. Thank you! We will also put a notice in the bulletins, etc regarding putting a scrap metal bin at your house for fall cleaning.

Concessions

We will have the concession stand open for Harvestfest and the Holiday Open House – need to sell the pop before it expires.

Leigh Anne Schares will coordinate concessions for winter basketball and wrestling for DB. We need to find someone to do the same for IC basketball and wrestling. Jammi will put out notices asking for volunteers.

Volleyball Tourn March 12-13, 2011 – Patty Rhoads will organize the tournament. Jammi will check with Shannon Hames on doing concessions for the tournament (only one location this year).

Merchandise and Apparel

Football profit @ \$1,100. Need to pay to football program. YTD profit @ \$1,600 and there are some outstanding bills to pay yet.

Suggested taking photos of the bleacher seats, bag chairs, flags, etc. and post them on the website so people know we have them. Kim will do this.

FUNDRAISING

Golf Outing

Pat Monat reported this year's tournament was organized a little different with sponsorships – they had a large VIP sign printed with VIP sponsors, programs printed and included list of all sponsors, also on placemats at dinner. They also have a lot of ideas/plans for sponsorships for next year's tournament – VIP sponsorship levels, etc. They will also approach vendors who do business with the school for potential sponsorships. Pat discussed a women's only tournament also (Columbus does this).

The committee designated 50% of the profit from the golf tournament would go to the technology fund at school. This was a joint effort between the Booster Club and the alumni association to split the proceeds from this event 50/50 between the Booster Club and the technology fund.

Holiday Open House

Saturday, Oct. 30th - Jammi only has a few spots open. She has put posters out to promote the event, also notices in bulletins, Courier, Pulse, PSA on radio and KWWL community calendar. She will have concessions open and will also offer gift wrapping.

Raffle

All agreed this time of year worked out well and we will do this in conjunction with Homecoming again next year. Profit this year @ \$13,800 compared to last year @ \$9,200.

Car

Pam Schares brought it to our attention that Hudson schools did a fundraiser with Ford. They work with a dealer to set up cars and anyone who test drives a car, they give us \$x for each person up to \$6000. Discussed doing this in the Tenth Inning parking lot. We will check into this further.

Idea

Mason City Newman holds what they call "Gods Portion Day" and raises a lot of money through this event. We will check into this further and discuss with Jeff Keen whether it's something we'd like to do also?

OLD BUSINESS

Ice Machine/Freezers

Carol Becker donated a freezer for the coach's room across from the concessions stand. This freezer will be used for ice. And Ed Weber donated a refrigerator/freezer which will go to the ball diamond concession stand. Theresa Klein has another one – maybe for the new gym? Thank you to all who donated these items!

Homecoming

Set up was ok but next year we would only have pop in the concession stand to avoid holding up the line. Discussed self serving food from two sides of the line? Having buns ready was a hold up. We should also have two locations to check out and pay for food at the end of the line. The pep rally inside the gym worked out very well.

NEW BUSINESS

Items for new concession stand in new building

Microwave

Cookie machine

Need to double check for proper wiring for all these items and where they will be located. Also need to contact Pepsi to get a pop cooler. Jammi will contact Vince to see layout and plans for the area and Kim will contact Pepsi about a pop cooler.
