Softball and Baseball orders will be the next merchandise orders, and possibly some generic summer DB merchandise.
- 3. Fundraising: Nothing to report at this time.

- 1. Glass for Trophy Case Rick has gotten one bid from Iowa Glass. Sheri will work on getting more bids and report back at the next meeting.
- 2. Trainer for summer sports We have a price quote from Cedar Valley Specialists for \$1700 for the summer home baseball and softball games. Sheri is getting a quote from Covenant for a sports trainer and will report back.

New Business:

- 2. Concession Coordinators The baseball/softball coordinators will be invited to the May meeting. Leigh Anne Schares will also be at the meeting to provide direction on concessions, ordering food, etc. for summer. It was also discussed that we need to re-visit the concession coordinator list for the 2014-2015 school year and determine if the number of coordinators is appropriate for each event. Rick has a meeting on April 12. We will discuss more after this. Blaine also mentioned that the June 21 home baseball game will be a large crowd. We will need to have extra workers and plenty of food.
- 3. Shakopee The Shakopee for the baseball/softball diamonds is being delivered on Thursday, April 3. The delivery is free so the only cost is the material which will be approximately \$400. Once received, Missy will send a "thank you" to the members hauling the material free of charge.
