Merchandise and Apparel

Patty Rhoads reported she ordered the baseball and softball merchandise and it should arrive this week. She ordered extra softball and baseball merchandise this time since she typically gets additional orders after the deadline.

The softball and baseball players will assist in selling the Cancer night t-shirts. The players's t-shirt will be free if they sell a minimum of 5 t-shirts.

The merchandise committee is also busy with merchandise for the softball tournament. There will be 4 options available and Patty is sending an order form to each school's athletic director for pre-orders along with adding it to the website. Also looking at selling Frogg Togg's at the softball tournament.

Added koozies to our merchandise – selling for \$3 each or 2 for \$5.

Patty is also looking at having some DB polos available at the golf outing along with some dri-fit generic merchandise.

FUNDRAISING

Football Sweepstakes

Kim Rottinghaus shared information on the football sweepstakes (similar to the basketball slam dunk we did earlier this year). With the football sweepstakes, we determine which 5 weeks of the football season we want to participate in and there are 5 winners each week giving away a total of \$200 each week (prizes awarded to the top 3 and bottom 2 score leaders).

Karen Paulsen reported the plans for the softball tournament were coming along fine. The tournament is scheduled for June 29th and 30th and they are still looking for volunteers.

Other Items

Discussion on hosting an All-Star game and the Lego League/Math Counts sponsorships were tabled until the August meeting.

Blaine Rhoads is still working on an alumni wrestling banquet on the Friday after Thanksgiving in conjunction with the Intrasquad meet.

Tom Hogan presented a proposal from Integrity Hardwood Floors in the amount approximately \$1600 to clean the gym floor. Approved to move forward with cleaning.

There was discussion on moving the annual Booster Club raffle to January instead of fall to spread out some of the fundraising efforts. No final decisions were made.

Karen Paulsen resigned from the Booster Club treasurer position effective June 30th, 2012 since she's now on the School Board.
