Nurse's Notes

We have seen a lot of insect stings as we start this year. Most stings cause a little redness, minimal swelling, discomfort and itching. To take care of an insect bite, look for a stinger, wash the area well. Apply a cool compress or ice pack. Applying a topical hydrocortisone or a baking soda paste may help. Taking an antihistamine can also relieve some of the discomfort. Scratching the area may introduce infection. Watch for increased swelling, redness or drainage. If someone is bitten and starts experiencing shortness of breath, swelling of the face, lips or eyelids, seek emergency assistance. Try to avoid areas where wasps or hornets may be. Mosquitoes are abundant right now also. Avoid standing water. Wear a repellent if tolerated. All too soon we will be seeing snow and cold temperatures and these pests will be gone. 
