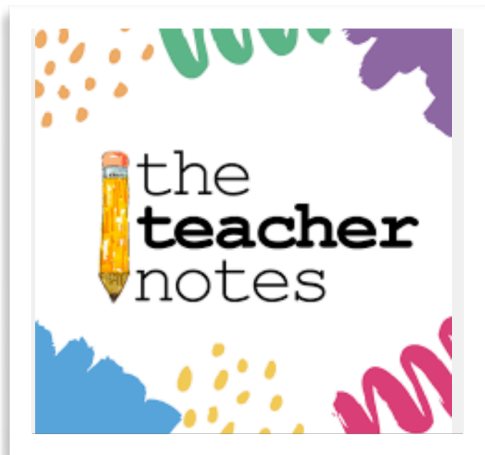
**From Mrs. Trueg....**

I now have one full week at BCSS under my belt and I can not say enough good things about what goes on within this school system. The knowledge and compassion that is shared with the students by the wonderful staff here is just awesome. The students are so very respectful and their roots run deep in their love of their faith.

I wanted to share a bit of what I get to do on a day to day basis. In my resource role, I have the opportunity to work with students who have academic needs. They have the opportunity to get their core instruction in the classroom from their classroom teacher. I provide support in addition to their core instruction by working with them daily on the skills they need a boost in. In my instructional coach role, I am looking forward to working closely with the amazing teachers here to infuse small group reading instruction into their daily literacy block. Additionally, some other opportunities I have are testing students, covering classrooms for teachers to test students, as well as attending several workshops for school leaders (along with Mrs. Ownby and Mrs. Douglas.)

This week and next we are testing (K-8) in FAST, MAPS and Heggerty. Getting plenty of sleep each night as well as eating a protein filled breakfast helps their brains perform at their best!

I just cannot say enough about this wonderful gem of a school and am blessed to have the opportunity to teach here and have my children attend here.

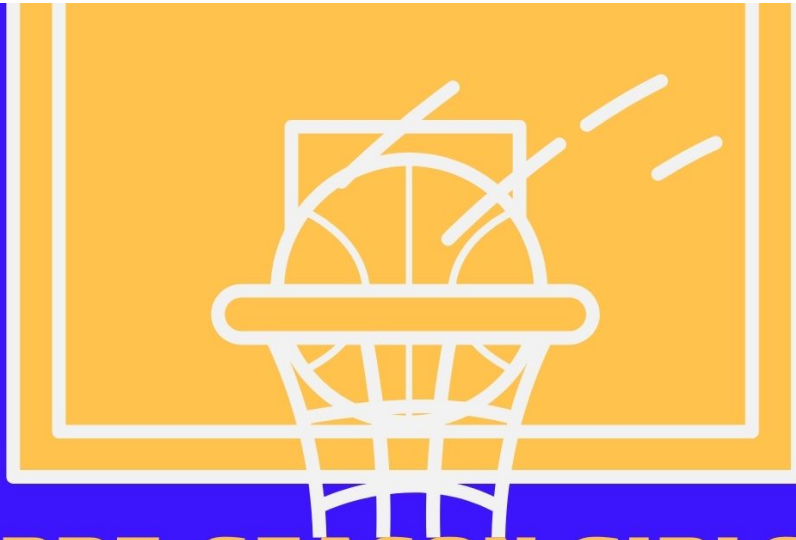
