From Mrs. Ownby...

Welcome back and welcome new families! I am Mrs. Ownby. I am an instructional coach for K-12. I am also our curriculum coordinator, mentor facilitator for new teachers, and data analyzer. I work behind the scenes to ensure students are receiving an education that is tailored to their needs and teachers have the support needed to successfully carry out our mission and teach academics with fidelity. One of my favorite things about my job is to track student progress through our standardized assessments (the assessments students take that are compared to other students across the state and nation). I love seeing how much growth our students make from fall to winter to spring. We have been doing many things over the last few years to ensure that progress is being made between these screening times. One initiative we worked hard to roll out last year was WIN (What I Need) time in K-5. We (the teachers and I) take time to determine what EACH child's gaps are, form groups with those gaps as focus areas, and spend 20 minutes a day for 3 to 6 weeks (or until the gaps are filled) to meet the needs of each student. These groups are mixed age meaning they will be grouped with kids from other grade levels who are working on the same skill. This year we are able to incorporate more adults into our groups allowing for smaller sized/more focused learning times. All students K-5 participate in a WIN group daily as either an intervention (support to close gaps) or an extension (to provide time to grow beyond grade level expectations). We are so excited to get started with our first set of groups on Monday! I look forward to seeing how this intense and direct instruction helps each child grow.

Parents will schedule conferences online with the Parent Teacher Conference (PTC) scheduler on our website. K-5 conferences will be scheduled in 15 minute increments. 6-8 and specials conferences will be scheduled in 10 minute increments. Instructions for scheduling conferences are below.

Conferences for grades K-5 should be scheduled with the student's homeroom teacher.

6-8 grade conferences:If the student's last name is A - L, please schedule with Mrs. Bergfeld (Mr. Armbruster will also be present). Last names M - Z, please schedule with Mrs. Zimmerman (Mr. Chicchelly will also be present). Middle school students only need one scheduled conference with Bergfeld/Armbruster or Zimmerman/Chicchelly. You will meet with the other set of teachers at the spring conference. You may schedule additional conferences with Mr. Knepper, Mr. Robinson and specials teachers.

Please sign in and schedule your conferences. You may schedule conferences from September 22 at 7:00am until October 8 at midnight. Anyone who does not schedule a conference time will be assigned a conference time. Please print or write down your conference schedule. You will not be able to go back to it after October 8 at midnight.

PTC Registration Process for Parents/Guardians

To Start

- Sign In or new families Sign Up

YOU ARE NOW AT THE PTC SCREEN

Signing Up for Parent-Teacher Conferences

K-5 conferences will be scheduled in 15-minute increments. Grades 6-8 + specials will be scheduled in 10-minute increments.

- **Step 1:** Choose the conference date and grade of students and you will be taken to a list of teachers.
- **Step 2:** Select the teacher(s) you wish to conference with from the list or start typing the last name in the "Search Teacher" field.

Note: You can reserve time with up to eight teachers. You can register for additional teachers once you complete the current process.

- **Step 3:** Enter the student's name.
- **Step 4:** Click continue.
- **Step 5:** Check the box next to the conference times(s) you wish to reserve.
- Step 6: Click Update.

The timeframe/s you chose will be colored green. Watch your times, do not double book with two teachers at the same time.

At this point you may sign up for conferences for additional students in that same grade group by clicking on the "Teacher Selection" button at the bottom of the page.

To schedule a student in another grade group click your name next to "Signed in as" then the "Home" (house) button, then repeat step 1-6.



At the bottom of the screen you will see the confirmation of your conference registration. You will have the option to "click here to print" to get a copy of your Conference Registration Report.
