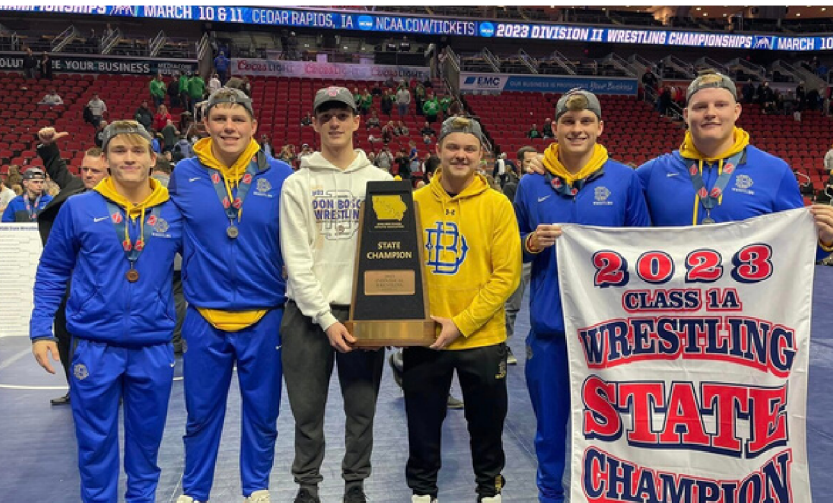

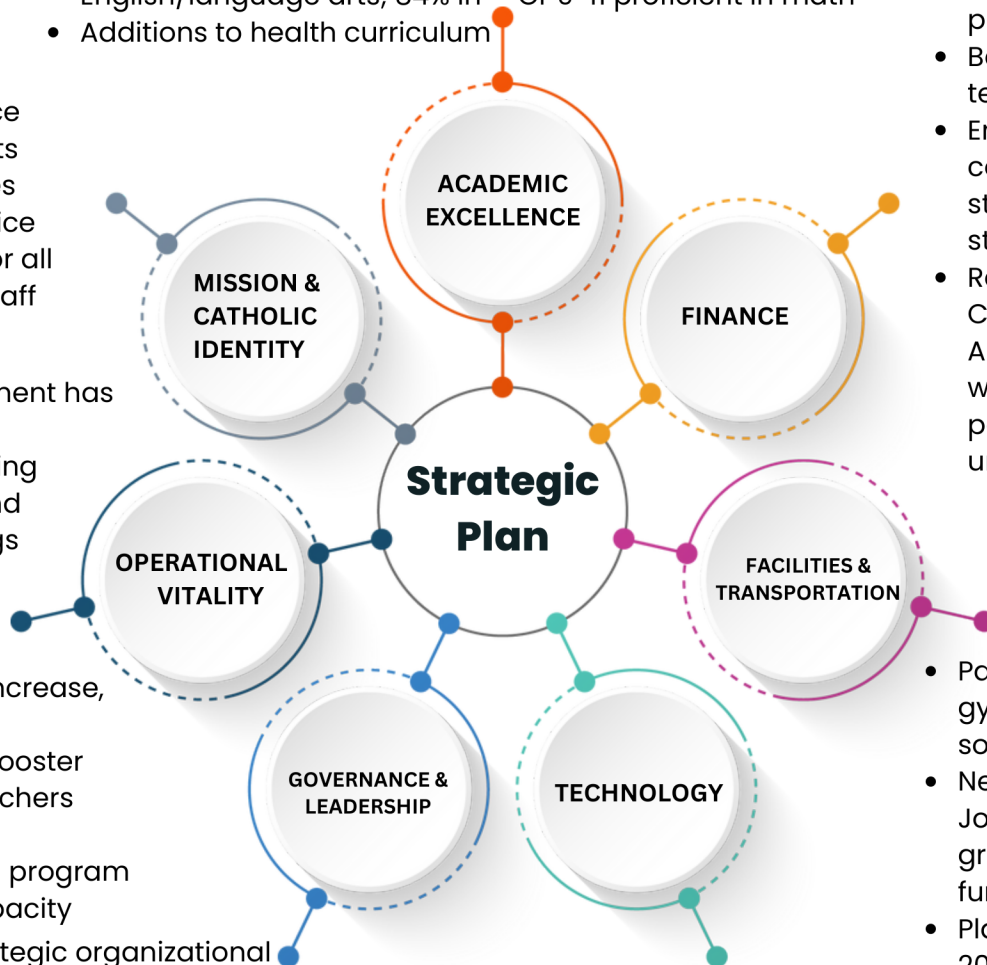

# Strategic Plan **PROGRESS**

In April 2023, we completed Strategic Planning work with our consultant and other schools in the Archdiocese of Dubuque. We continued moving toward our goals by addressing objectives in the seven listed areas. Notable progress includes the following.

- Annual retreat for high school students
- 2nd Gr/8th Gr prayer partner retreat
- Grade 12 theology includes a unit on living the Catholic faith in college
- Instituted service learning projects in K-Gr 8 classes
- Increasing service opportunities for all students and staff
- Focused professional development centered on strong core instruction with an emphasis on formative assessment
- 100% of K-5 teachers plus our two instructional coaches taking LETRS training to support reading instruction, putting us way ahead of other schools
- Curriculum review and updates including new class offerings
- Increased awareness of Advanced Placement and dual-credit opportunities for high school students
- Increased training for preschool staff to enhance programming
- Continued integration of the Leader in Me Program into curriculum and MTSS (multi-tiered systems of support) for student success
- 87% of students in Gr 3-8 proficient in English/language arts; 81% in Gr 3-8 proficient in math; 87% in Gr 9-11 proficient in English/language arts; 84% in Gr 9-11 proficient in math
- Additions to health curriculum
- 5 year budget projection completed
- Began increasing teacher base salary
- Endowment committee with a strategic investment strategy
- Renaming Salesian Call to Bosco Strong Annual Appeal and working to increase participation in unrestricted gift giving
- Painting in high school gym, preschool, and some classrooms
- New playground at St. Joseph Preschool with grant and donor funding
- Planning for summer 2024 facility upgrades in Immaculate Conception with Fun Run profit
- Assessment of security needs for spring 2024 upgrades with Homeland Security Grant (cameras, door access, and lighting)



- Preschool enrollment has grown to 30+
- Focus on marketing of our mission and Education Savings Accounts led to increased registration for fall 2023 (IC 6% increase, DB 15% increase)
- Active PTO and Booster Club support teachers and students
- ABC after-school program at maximum capacity

- Strategic organizational model with one K-12 principal
- New BCSS Leadership Team
- New procedures for training, informing, and involving school board members
- Board and foundation subcommittees to fulfill mission and achievement of strategic plan

- Designed technology rotation plan to continue 1:1 technology use in grades 6-12
- Implementing technology controls to enhance academic and spiritual development

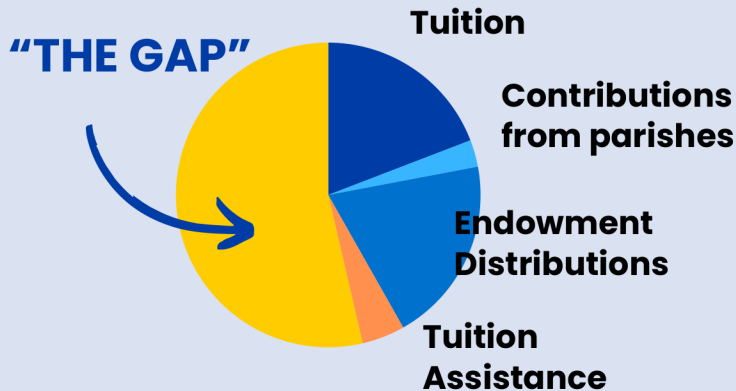
